

Pioneer Gap – Fundamental needs and the innovators seeking to develop solutions to unmet needs traditionally suffer a ‘pioneer gap’. Innovators are forced to develop solutions in **intense austerity**. The belief that austerity drives more frequent and higher quality innovations is unfounded.

The power of collective action focused with strategic innovation allows for bigger, deeper support. The new IOE model becomes irresistible to finance and impossible for government interests to bypass.

Engagement Gap – Government and financial interests become more aware of the power of collective action with more IOEs defining the civilization field.

US household wealth alone hit \$88 TRILLION in 2016 (Fed).

Credit Suisse’s 2013 *Global Wealth Report* revealed an all-time high of \$241 trillion, up 4.9% since 2012 and 68% since 2003, with USA accounting for 72% of the increase. **Overall lack of wealth is not a primary civilization challenge.**
